

Census 2020 and Civic Engagement

- Invest **\$40M** in community-based outreach around the 2020 Census to ensure a fair, accurate, and complete count for New York State
- Allocate **\$6.4M** for Early Voting, which would allow all registered New Yorkers greater flexibility in casting their ballot

Driver's Licenses

- Pass legislation ensuring that New York's "Standard" licenses be accessible to all state residents, regardless of immigration status

Health Care and Coverage

- Allocate **\$532M** to create a state-funded Essential Plan for ALL New Yorkers up to 200% of the federal poverty level, regardless of immigration status

Legal Services

- Double the Liberty Defense Project Funding to **\$20M**
- Increase the Office of New Americans budget to **\$10M**

Multi-Generational Education

- Invest **\$15.3M** to fund high-quality, community-based adult literacy instruction and address the service gap created by the transition to the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act
- Invest **\$10M** in Family Literacy to fund community-based organizations to expand or launch family literacy programs and support relevant capacity-building
- Provide **\$100M** for English Language Learners (ELLs) to bolster school districts' ability to meet their legal obligations to serve ELLs
- Ensure New York State's DREAMERS can access critical tuition assistance programs

Protect and Defend

- Pass a TRUST Act to limit local police involvement in federal immigration enforcement
- Pass Protect Our Courts Act, which would significantly curb predatory ICE apprehension activities in New York State Courthouses
- Pass legislation to reduce the maximum potential sentence on class A misdemeanor offenses from 365 to 364 days
- Expand and codify Executive Order 26 to enhance language access protections
- Pass the New York State Farmworker Fair Labor Practices Act
