Due to a scheduling conflict, the New York City Department of Transportation Division of Bridges will replace motors in the ventilation system in the FDR Drive tunnel between 90th and 80th Streets on **Tuesday May 31st**, replacing the originally announced date of May 24th. Work begins at 11:00 p.m. and continues through 5:00 a.m. the next morning. To accommodate this work traffic lane closures are necessary. Please note that one traffic lane adjacent to the center lane must be closed to protect personnel working in the center lane. As this operation is weather sensitive, rain dates are June 1st, 2nd or 3rd. The schedule of closures follows:

Southbound FDR Lane Closures

Right Lane: 11:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. (the next day)

Right and Center Lane: 1:00 a.m. to 5:00 a.m.

Tuesday, May 31, 2011

One lane of traffic will remain open at all times.

All Lanes Reopen at 5:00 a.m.
