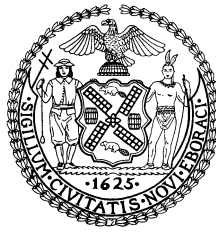

On April 29, the Task Force met to discuss the response to the Charter Review Commission's Report and to prepare testimony for the Manhattan hearing the Charter Commission is holding on May 9. The Committee reviewed the ULURP proposal, comments about a comprehensive city plan, and powers to the Borough President. The Task Force decided to prepare testimony on these points and to reiterate our position that mayoral zoning overrides should be prohibited. Some of the Task Force members agreed to analyze the Commission's review of various reports and plans required in the Charter and to recommend a position for the Task Force.

The Task Force further agreed, as it has in previous resolutions, that more community input is required and that factors, such as neighborhood preservation, displacement and infrastructure, should be part of a City plan.
